In regards to Attachment A Scope of Services, Under the FINAL PLANS portion of the scope of services, item 5 states "Bridge backwater and water surface profiles shall be calculated according to the latest edition of the FHWA computer program WSPRO, Water Surface Profile. Is HEC-RAS, (Hydrologic Engineering Center's River Analysis System), acceptable to use on this contract for bridge hydraulic analysis?
- A1. Yes DOTD will accept calculations using HEC-RAS.

- Q2. Is roadway lighting expected to be part of the scope of work?
- A2. No.
- Q3. What is an "electronic data processing applications" referring to?
- A3. The "electronic data processing applications" is referring to the design software.
- Q4. What is the magnitude and scope of expected sanitary drainage?
- A4. In cases where the owner of the sanitary utility is unable to afford the cost to relocate the utility, DOTD may absorb these cost by including the relocation in the construction plans.
