Retainer Contracts No. 4400004012 & 4400004013 Retainer Contracts for Stage 0 Studies Statewide

- Q1. Does the 3% DBE/WBE goal apply to both of the above referenced contracts or only to the latter?
- A1. The 3% applies to both contracts.
- Q2. I am seeking confirmation under the Minimum Personnel Requirements for the need of two (2) Certified Professional Traffic Operations Engineers identified in Item No. 4 (b) which states, "Two Professional Civil Engineers registered in the State of Louisiana, with a minimum of five years experience in traffic analysis and certified as Professional Traffic Operations Engineers (PTOE)." Historically, Stage 0 projects with the Department have required only one PTOE, and has seemed adequate enough to handle the level of a Stage 0 type project. By this requirement, LADOTD has narrowed the competition to a select few companies.
- A2. The two PTOE requirement for Stage 0 Studies are justified. The majority of the Stage 0 Studies have very large traffic components.
- Q3. Is it possible that the Minimum Personnel Requirement for a Registered Engineer with five years of Bridge Design Experience under No. 3 be provided by a Sub Consultant rather than the Prime Consultant?
- A3. Yes. Please see Addendum.
- Q4. Can you provide the overall percentages to be used in Item 8a of our proposal?
- A4. The Department does not specify the percentages between the Prime and their Sub-Consultants. The Project Manager does not wish to provide a breakdown in terms of percentages for each task listed in the scope of services. The data including the percentage breakdown of these tasks in the 24-102 submittal by the Prime helps the Evaluation Team determine the experience level and the firm's ability to assess the project's needs.
- Q5. Is it possible for an Engineering Firm to be awarded a new Stage 0 Retainer Contract before their current one had ended or maxed out?
- A5. Yes.
